

ORDERS OF COMMISSIONERS COURT  
BEXAR COUNTY, TEXAS

TUESDAY, MARCH 27, 2002

DUE TO A LOCAL EMERGENCY AND THREAT TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH OF MANY COUNTY RESIDENTS WHOSE HOMES AND PROPERTY WERE DESTROYED OR SEVERELY DAMAGED BY A STORM THAT MOVED THROUGH BEXAR COUNTY ON MARCH 19<sup>TH</sup>, 2002 AND BECAUSE THERE IS NOW AN IMMINENT THREAT TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THESE AFFECTED RESIDENTS AND BECAUSE THE STORM AND ITS DEVASTATING RESULTS WERE REASONABLY UNFORESEEABLE, THE EMERGENCY MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS COURT WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY COUNTY JUDGE NELSON W. WOLFF AT 10:40 A.M.

COMMISSIONER COURT - ITEM 1  
ORDER REQUESTING COUNTY COMMISSIONERS ROBERT TEJEDA AND TOMMY ADKISSON TO DEVELOP A PLAN THAT WOULD SET THE CRITERIA FOR ANY DEVELOPER, OF MANUFACTURED HOMES, WHO MAY MATCH COUNTY FUNDS TO HELP THE CITIZENS WHOSE HOMES WERE DAMAGED OR DESTROYED AND THAT THE PLAN BE BROUGHT TO THE APRIL 10, 2002 MEETING OF THE BEXAR COUNTY HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION FOR CONSIDERATION.

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Lyle Larson, duly seconded by County Commissioner Tommy Adkisson, which motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners Tejada, Larson, Adkisson and Judge Wolff voting "Aye". It is ordered by the Court that County Commissioners Robert Tejada and Tommy Adkisson be, and hereby are, requested to develop a plan that would set the criteria for any developer, of manufactured homes, who may match county funds to held the citizens whose homes were damaged or destroyed and that the plan be brought to the April 10, 2002 meeting of the Bexar County Housing Finance Corporation for consideration.

ORDER APPROVING ALLOCATION OF FY 2000 AND FY 2001  
HOME PROGRAM FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT \$374,976.00 TO BE  
USED TOWARDS REHABILITATION OF HOMES  
(MANUFACTURED AND STICK) THAT WERE DAMAGED 50%  
OR MORE OF THE VALUE OF THE HOME DURING THE  
MARCH 19, 2002 STORMS.**

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Robert Tejada, duly seconded by County Commissioner Tommy Adkisson, which motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners Tejada, Larson, Adkisson and Judge Wolff voting "Aye". It is ordered by the Court that the allocation of FY 2000 and FY 2001 HOME Program funds in the amount \$374,976.00 to be used towards rehabilitation of homes (manufactured and stick) that were damaged 50% or more of the value of the home during the March 19, 2002 storms.
