HE WAS ALWAYS POLITICALLY INVOLVED VOTING AT EVERY ELECTION AND INVOLVED IN VARIOUS SOUTHSIDE CAMPAIGNS. HE WAS KNOWN FOR HIS PASTIME ACTIVITIES, WHICH WERE DANCING, BASEBALL AND FISHING. MR. VIAGRAN IS SURVIVED BY HIS WIFE OF 62 YEARS, CELIA AND HIS 11 CHILDREN, FIVE SONS AND 6 DAUGHTERS; 5 GRANDSONS; 10 GRANDDAUGHTERS; 2 GREAT-GRANDSONS AND THREE GREAT-GREAT GRANDDAUGHTERS; BROTHERS AND SISTERS.
