HE WAS A MEMBER OF THE TEXAS HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES FROM 1967 TO 1983, WHERE HE SERVE AS CHAIR OF THE BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY COMMITTEE FOR EIGHT YEARS AND CHAIR OF THE DALLAS LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION FOR 10 YEARS. FOR THREE YEARS, MR. SEMOS SERVED AS CHAIRMAN OF BAYLOR COLLEGE OF DENTISTRY. HE AND HIS FAMILY OWNED AND OPERATED THE LANDMARK TORCH RESTAURANT FOR 50 YEARS. MR. SEMOS WAS THE FOUNDING CHAIR OF THE 1086 TEXAS SESQUICENTENNIAL COMMISSION AND IS OFTEN REFERRED TO AS THE AFATHER@OF THE TEXAS SESQUICENTENNIAL. MR. SEMOS HAS LONG BEEN AN ACTIVE MEMBER OF THE DALLAS GREEK COMMUNITY, AND IN MAY HE WAS AWARDED THE PRESTIGIOUS ELLIS ISLAND MEDAL OF HONOR, WHICH IS GIVEN TO OUTSTANDING AMERICAN CITIZENS OF DIFFERENT ANCESTRAL GROUPS.
