A LETTER OF CONDOLENCE IS TO BE SENT TO THE FAMILY OF CLYDE JOHN BENNETT JOHNSON, JR. EXPRESSING TO THEM THE SYMPATHY OF THE COURT ON THE LOSS OF THEIR LOVED ONE. MR. JOHNSON WAS BORN OCTOBER 31, 1917 IN AUSTIN, TEXAS WHERE HIS PARENTS, ADDIE MAE BROWN JOHNSON AND CLYDE JOHN BENNETT JOHNSON, SR. WERE TEMPORARILY RESIDING. THE FAMILY RETURNED TO THEIR HOME IN SAN ANTONIO, WHERE HE RESIDED THROUGHOUT HIS LIFE. MR. JOHNSON ATTENDED THE ALAMO HEIGHTS SCHOOLS. FOLLOWING HIS GRADUATION FROM THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS, MR. JOHNSON WORKED AS AN ACCOUNTANT, THEN ACCEPTED A POSITION AS ASSISTANT TO THE COMPTROLLER AT JOSKE'S OF TEXAS. ON JANUARY 12, 1942, MR. JOHNSON WAS APPOINTED A SPECIAL AGENT OF THE FBI AND SERVED THE BUREAU IN WASHINGTON, D.C., NEWARK, NEW JERSEY, ST. LOUIS AND SAN ANTONIO. HE ALSO WORKED ON SPECIAL ASSIGNMENTS AND SERVED ON THE FBI INSPECTION STAFF WHERE HE WORKED ON SEVERAL MAJOR CASES, INCLUDING THE PRESIDENT JOHN KENNEDY ASSASSINATION AND THE JULIUS AND ETHEL ROSENBERG SPY CASE. HE RETIRED FROM THE FBI IN 1968. MR. JOHNSON IS SURVIVED BY HIS WIFE OF 63 YEARS, DOROTHY MUSGRAVE JOHNSON; 3 SONS, CLYDE JOHNSON III, MARK JOHNSON AND MIKE JOHNSON; GRANDCHILDREN AND GREAT-GRANDCHILDREN.
