A LETTER OF CONDOLENCE IS TO BE SENT TO THE FAMILY OF VIRGINIA CASTORENO ZAMORA EXPRESSING TO THEM THE SYMPATHY OF THE COURT ON THE LOSS OF THEIR LOVED ONE. AS A NURSE, MS. ZAMORA WAS AN ADVOCATE FOR PATIENTS= RIGHTS, BUT SHE FOUGHT FOR THE LARGER COMMUNITY BY PRODDING THE CITY TO CLEANUP JUNK AND AUTO SALVAGE YARDS AND TO BUILD THE QUINTANA ROAD STORM DRAINAGE SYSTEM. MS. ZAMORA WAS A MEMBER OF THE ST. JOSEPH OF SOUTH SAN CHURCH\$ COMMUNITIES ORGANIZED FOR PUBLIC SERVICE (COPS) COMMITTEE AND FREQUENTLY APPEARED BEFORE THE CITY COUNCIL TO PROMOTE SAFER, CLEANER NEIGHBORHOODS. AFTER YEARS OF COPS= URGING THE CITY TO ADOPT TOUGHER REGULATIONS AGAINST JUNKYARDS, THE CITY COUNCIL FINALLY DID IN 1998. A GRADUATE OF THE ROBERT B. GREEN SCHOOL OF NURSING, HER FIRST JOB WAS WITH THE UNIVERSITY HEALTH SYSTEM. MORE THAN 20 YEARS LATER, MS. ZAMORA OBTAINED A DEGREE IN NURSING FROM THEN INCARNATE WORD COLLEGE. LAST YEAR, COMMISSIONERS COURT BESTOWED THE HIDALGO AWARD ON MS. ZAMORA IN RECOGNITION OF HER WORK ON BEHALF OF HER NEIGHBORHOOD. MS. ZAMORA IS SURVIVED BY HER BROTHERS, RAUL, YNOCENCIO C. RICHARD C., TONY C. AND ROBERT C. ZAMORA.
