A LETTER OF CONDOLENCE IS TO BE SENT TO THE FAMILY OF FRED CLINTON CAMPBELL EXPRESSING TO THEM THE SYMPATHY OF THE COURT ON THE LOSS OF THEIR LOVED ONE. MR. CAMPBELL WAS BORN IN THE FARMING COMMUNITY OF COTTONWOOD IN HENDERSON COUNTY, TEXAS MARCH 18, 1918 AND WAS DESCENDED FROM ONE OF EAST TEXAS=PIONEER FAMILIES. MR. CAMPBELL ENLISTED IN THE ARMY AIR CORP IN 1941 AND SERVED IN THE FIJI ISLAND DURING WORLD WAR II. HE WAS SELECTED FOR OFFICER CANDIDATE SCHOOL IN 1943. MR. CAMPBELL WAS COMMISSIONED A SECOND LIEUTENANT AND REMAINED ON ACTIVE DUTY UNTIL 1945. HE WAS REACTIVATED FOR THE KOREAN CONFLICT IN 1950. HIS CAREER WAS SPENT WITH THE AIR FORCE AS AN ACTIVE DUTY OFFICER, CIVILIAN EMPLOYEE AND RESERVE OFFICER. MR. CAMPBELL IS SURVIVED BY HIS BROTHER HERSHEL CAMPBELL; DAUGHTER, CAROLE WESTBROOK; SONS, JAMES R. AND DR. FRED C. CAMPBELL, JR.; SIX GRANDCHILDREN AND ONE GREAT-GRANDCHILD.
