When the following proceedings were had to-wit:

A letter of condolence is to be sent to the family of James Dement expressing to them the sympathy of the Court on the loss of their loved. He grew up during the Depression and dropped out of high school to join the Marine Corps during World War II at the age of 17. He served in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Division in Guam and was honorably discharged after the end of the War. He earned his GED and attended U. T. briefly and then returned to Dallas where he worked for Cecil Owen, his step-father-in-law, pouring concrete steps for 75 cents an hour. Within a short time, he offered Owen \$2,000, which he didn't have at the time, to buy his concrete business. That was the beginning of his successful venture into the contracting and development business, borrowing \$1 million for his business by the age of 21. In 1962, after 18 years in Dallas, building in 20 states, he bet all he had on San Antonio, seeing a promising future in this great city. He is survived by his wife, Kirsten Dement, son, Daylon Dement; 4 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren, and numerous nieces and nephews.
