Discussion was held regarding the 2013 ad valorem tax rate for the Bexar County Hospital District d/b/a University Health System and approval of an order of Bexar County Commissioners Court setting the 2013 tax rate and levying the 2013 taxes for the Bexar County Hospital District d/b/a University Health System. (Record)

The Court hereby ordered and approved a motion approving an Order of Bexar County Commissioners Court setting the 2013 ad valorem tax rate for the Bexar County Hospital District d/b/a/ University Health System for FY 2014 and levying a tax rate of \$0.276235 per \$100 valuation, which is effectively a 3.07% increase in the tax rate. (Record)

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Paul Elizondo, duly seconded by County Commissioner Sergio "Chico" Rodriguez, which motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners Rodriguez, Elizondo, Wolff, Adkisson, and Judge Wolff voting "Aye".

The Court hereby ordered and approved a motion approving an Order adopting the FY2013 ad valorem tax rate for Bexar County Hospital District d/b/a University Health System for Maintenance and Operation (M&O) at the rate of \$0.236600 per \$100 valuation of all taxable property situated in Bexar County, Texas. (Record)

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Paul Elizondo, duly seconded by County Commissioner Tommy Adkisson, which motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners Rodriguez, Elizondo, Wolff, Adkisson, and Judge Wolff voting "Aye".

The Court hereby ordered and approved a motion approving an Order adopting the FY2013 ad valorem tax rate for Bexar County Hospital District d/b/a University Health System for principal and interest at a rate of \$0.039635 per \$100 valuation of all taxable property situated in Bexar County, Texas. (Record)

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Paul Elizondo, duly seconded by County Commissioner Sergio "Chico" Rodriguez, which motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners Rodriguez, Elizondo, Wolff, Adkisson, and Judge Wolff voting "Aye".
