He served as a U.S. Navy corpsman attached to the U.S. Marines in Korea. He was awarded a Bachelor of Arts Degree from St. Mary's University and a Master's Degree in Counseling from Our Lady of the Lake University. He was also a Fulbright Scholar sent to the Middle East for studies. Mr. Guardia was passionate about education and spent most of his career teaching, counseling, and finally in administration in the San Antonio Independent School District. William was a long time principal of Ira Ogden Elementary School. He was a proponent of bilingual education and was sent to Washington D.C. for the National Education Association in support of bilingual education. In his retirement, he was a member of the Retired Teachers Association, where he was an active member of the book committee. Mr. Guardia served as a volunteer photographer covering special events for the SAISD. He is survived by his sister Zulema G. Reina and many other loving family members and friends.
