The Court hereby ordered and approved a motion approving the Orders necessary for the conduct of the Tuesday, April 21, 2015 Special Runoff Election to include the following: (Record)

An Order calling the Special Runoff Election;
An Order designating the main early voting location and branch locations;
An Order setting compensation for the deputy early voting clerks for early voting;
An Order adopting a Resolution designating the number of clerks authorized;
An Order adopting a Resolution for the rate of pay for Election Day judges and clerks;
An Order designating the rate of pay for 2 temporary employees for the by mail process.

Discussion was held regarding the intermediate design of the San Pedro Creek Restoration Project. (Record)

The Court hereby ordered and approved a motion approving the intermediate design documents as required by the Cooperative Agreement between Bexar County and the San Antonio River Authority and directing staff and the San Antonio River Authority to proceed with the completion of 70% design documents to be presented to Commissioners Court at a future date. (Record)

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Paul Elizondo, duly seconded by County Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez, which motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners Rodriguez, Elizondo, Wolff, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye”.

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Paul Elizondo, duly seconded by County Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez, to withdraw the motion taken on agenda item 3. Motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners Rodriguez, Elizondo, Wolff, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye”. Motion carried.

The Court hereby ordered and approved a motion approving the 40% design of the San Pedro Creek Improvements Project and authorizing the San Antonio River Authority to proceed with the 70% design and securing the donation of the right-of-way needed to construct the first two phases; with Phase 1 of the project to be complete by May 2018, on the 300th Anniversary of the founding of San Antonio. (Record)

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Paul Elizondo, duly seconded by County Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez, which motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners Rodriguez, Elizondo, Wolff, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye”.
