He was an Altar boy, an Eagle Scout and rose to be the Tejas-Mission Scout Commissioner. He was proud to be a Marine in the First Marine Air Wing Division, a Naval Cadet, and a Commander with the Coast Guard Reserve and to retire as a Lieutenant Colonel with the Air Force Reserve as an Engineering Staff Officer. George bled burnt orange, graduating in 1956 with a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from the University of Texas at Austin. In 1964, he became the First American, in Texas to become a City Manager. City Manager of Crystal City, which also was the beginning of his political career. He proudly started his own Consulting Engineering Firm, Ozuna & Associates in 1966. Being on the SAC Board, George, Delia Acosta, John Courage, Dan Martinez and many of their friends, fought hard and finally, the Palo Alto College Campus for the Southwest part of San Antonio was built in November 1997. The Library on the Palo Alto College Campus is known as the George Ozuna Jr. Learning and Resource Center and inside is the Ozuna Children's Library. George is survived by his loving wife of 58 years, Yolanda; children, George, Kenneth, Jessica and Jocelyn; and 3 grandchildren and other loving family members and friends.
