Discussion was held regarding the Bexar County FY 2019-20 Proposed Operating and Capital Budget, including but not limited to, proposed changes to be included in a memorandum from the Budget Officer for presentation to Commissioners Court on Tuesday, September 10, 2019. (Record)

The Court hereby ordered and approved a motion accepting the Capital Improvements for Harlandale Civic Center \$250,000, South San Civic Center \$150,000, and SAY SI West Side Campus \$333,333.

A motion was presented by County Commissioner Justin Rodriguez, duly seconded by County Commissioner Sergio "Chico" Rodriguez, which motion was voted on as follows: Commissioners S. Rodriguez, J. Rodriguez, Wolff, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting "Aye".

A motion was presented by Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez, duly seconded by Commissioner Tommy Calvert, to approve \$35,000 to the Somerset Senior Citizen Center.

Motion was voted on as follows: Commissioner S. Rodriguez, J. Rodriguez, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye” and Commissioner Wolff voting “Nay”.

Motion carried.

A motion was presented by Commissioner Tommy Calvert, duly seconded by Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez, to approve \$100,000 to the Solid Waste Program.

Motion was voted on as follows: Commissioner S. Rodriguez, J. Rodriguez, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye” and Commissioner Wolff voting “Nay”.

Motion carried.

A motion was presented by Commissioner Justin Rodriguez, duly seconded by Commissioner Tommy Calvert, to approve \$15,000 to the YWCA Breast Health Education and \$15,000 to Girls Inc.

Motion was voted on as follows: Commissioner S. Rodriguez, J. Rodriguez, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye” and Commissioner Wolff voting “Nay”.

Motion carried.

A motion was presented by Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez, duly seconded by Commissioner Tommy Calvert, to approve \$20,000 to Seniors in Play.

Motion was voted on as follows: Commissioner S. Rodriguez, J. Rodriguez, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye” and Commissioner Wolff voting “Nay”.

Motion carried.

A motion was presented by Commissioner Tommy Calvert, duly seconded by Commissioner Justin Rodriguez, to approve \$50,000 to the Texas’s Old Spanish Trail Cultural Corridor.

Motion was voted on as follows: Commissioner S. Rodriguez, J. Rodriguez, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye” and Commissioner Wolff voting “Nay”.

Motion carried.

A motion was presented by Commissioner Kevin A. Wolff to take the \$1,900,000 to decrease the tax rate.

Motion failed for lack of second.

A motion was presented by Commissioner Justin Rodriguez, duly seconded by Commissioner Tommy Calvert, to approve \$100,000 to Precinct 2 Westside Reinvestment Initiative.

Motion was voted on as follows: Commissioner S. Rodriguez, J. Rodriguez, Calvert, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye” and Commissioner Wolff voting “Nay”.

Motion carried.

A motion was presented by Commissioner Kevin A. Wolff to take the balance of \$736,000 remaining and be divided by four and let the 4 precincts submit their list back to the Court, Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez seconded the motion. Motion was amended by Commissioner Kevin A. Wolff, duly seconded by Commissioner Sergio “Chico” Rodriguez, to set the \$736,000 balance up in contingency and if any commissioner has something that he wants to fund to bring it to Court and make a decision at that time.

Motion was voted on as follows: Commissioner S. Rodriguez, J. Rodriguez, Wolff, and Judge Wolff voting “Aye” and Commissioner Calvert voting “Nay”.

Motion carried.

The Court hereby ordered and approved a motion accepting the proposed changes to the Bexar County FY2019-20 Proposed Operating and Capital Budget, including but not limited to, proposed changes to be included in a memorandum from the Budget Officer for presentation to Commissioners Court on Tuesday, September 10, 2019.
